SURVIVOR WINDOW AND DOOR PRODUCTS LIMITED WARRANTY

SURVIVOR, a leading manufacturer since 1934, provides vinyl windows and patio doors in accordance with the highest standards of engineering and products performance.

SURVIVOR warrants to all consumers of SURVIVOR Window and Door Products that the parts are free from manufacturing defects, and will not peel, corrode, rot, warp, blister or fade. SURVIVOR agrees to provide free replacement of the components that contain manufacturing defects for the lifetime of the original purchaser. In the event of transfer of the warranty, the warranty period shall be for fifty (50) years from the original date of installation. SURVIVOR warrants that the hardware parts shall be free from defects for a period of five (5) years. SURVIVOR will replace the part if it finds it to be defective. SURVIVOR will not be responsible for shipping charges or labor cost.

NOT COVERED UNDER THIS WARRANTY IS BROKEN GLASS OF ANY KIND OR SCREENS.

This warranty shall be valid only after the registration certificate is filled in by the dealer, signed by the original purchaser and mailed to SURVIVOR within thirty (30) days after completion of installation.

This limited warranty is transferable by the original owner to subsequent owners of the property, provided SURVIVOR receives written notice of transfer of the property within thirty (30) days after the transfer date, accompanied by a Three (\$3.00) Dollar per window transfer fee. Failure to so notify SURVIVOR of the transfer shall relieve SURVIVOR of any further obligation hereunder. Additionally, the consumer must produce the original invoice(s) for the window(s) and must pay a Ten (\$10.00) Dollar processing fee to SURVIVOR, whenever a warranty is transferred.

SURVIVOR warrants that its insulating glass units will be free from material obstruction of vision as a result of dust or film formation on the internal glass surfaces caused by failure of the hermetic seal due to faulty manufacturing of the unit. This warranty on the insulating glass shall extend for a period of twenty (20) years for windows and patio doors after the date of manufacture. Condensation is the natural result of excess moisture in the atmosphere of the house, does not indicate a faulty product and is not covered under this warranty. The Warranty is limited to the repair or replacement of defective parts, and does not apply to products damaged by acts of God, abuse or misuse.

If you feel that the components of SURVIVOR products installed on your home are not free from manufacturing defects, write to Customer Service Department of SURVIVOR, 1441 Chestnut Avenue, Hillside, New Jersey 07205, describing the claimed defect. Manufacturer will bear no other expense such as labor costs of any kind, freight, removal, or reinstallation.

SURVIVOR reserves the right to discontinue or make changes in any of its products, including changing the color of its vinyl products, without notice to the original purchaser or subsequent owner and shall not be liable to the original purchaser or subsequent owner as a result of such discontinuance or changes. In the event the products covered by this warranty are not available, SURVIVOR shall have the right to substitute a product or part that, in SURVIVOR's discretion, is of equal quality or price.

SURVIVOR MAKES NO EXPRESS WARRANTIES, EXCEPT AS ARE SET FORTH HEREIN AND SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR AN INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES WITH RESPECT TO THE VINYL PRODUCTS AND ACCESSORIES BY SURVIVOR COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY. ITS COMPLETE LIABILITY AND THE OWNER'S EXCLUSIVE REMEDY BEING LIMITED TO REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT ON THE BASIS STATED HEREIN. SOME STATES DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OF INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, SO THE ABOVE LIMITATION OR EXCLUSION MAY NOT APPLY.

PROOF OF PURCHASE WILL BE REQUIRED WHEN SUBMITTING A WARRANTY CLAIM.
